KYLE JOHNSON: CREATING A DYNAMIC SUCCULENT GARDEN

Have you been collecting and hoarding succulents and cacti in nursery pots for years? Struggling to get started turning your collection into a garden showcase? Kyle will be speaking about overcoming the hurdles of creating your dream succulent garden. This includes design elements, mound building techniques, soil mixtures, irrigation, container gardening and evaluating microclimates. Kyle is a self-taught plant/gardener enthusiast who enjoys creating spaces where the magnificent plant world can be admired by humans and pollinators alike. Hopefully you can incorporate some of his concepts into your own gardens.



January Program

Kyle is a professional geologist with the Central Valley Water Quality Control Board and works on environmental cleanups for the State's legacy gold, copper, and mercury mines. He grew up in Tucson, Arizona and attended the University of Arizona. In 2016, he and his partner Hannah moved to Sacramento from Anchorage, Alaska and in 2018 purchased their first home in the Tahoe Park Community. In 2019, Kyle stumbled across Gerhard Bock's Succulents and More blog on everything succulent-related and quickly got inspired. Over the past 5 years, he has worked relentlessly creating a garden filled with succulents, cacti, CA natives, and perennials. He has a true admiration for aloes, with over 200 species/hybrids planted. Kyle also uses his garden as an outlet for creating metal and rock art, among other whimsical objects.


